Craving sunshine and piña colodas? Resorts are welcoming guests seeking to escape, and here's what you can expect while on a resort vacation:



Guest Room Safety Modifications

In-room amenities are sanitized and vacuum-sealed between guests. Nonessential high-touch items that can't be disinfected are removed.



Certified Cleaning in Guest Rooms

Guest rooms sealed with a badge to certify that they have been deep cleaned and thoroughly sanitized between guests.



Additional Hygiene Stations Available

Hand sanitizer conveniently placed at restaurants, spa, gym, elevators, and guest rooms.



Health Screenings

Temperature checks, thermal scans, hand and shoe sanitation, disinfecting of luggage.



Enhanced Cleaning and Sanitation

Increased cleaning and sanitation in public areas such as elevators, restrooms, restaurants, spa, gym, and all handrails throughout the premises.



Reduced Contact

Choice of in-person or online check-in and check-out, with plexiglass or screen separators.



Dining Modifications

Buffets have been replaced with ala carte dining, or in many instances, they are now full-service.



Increased Resort Vehicle Sanitation

Regularly disinfected resort transfer vehicles operating at limited occupancy with sanitation kits



Elevator Usage Modifications

Monitored limited occupancy in elevators.



Reduced Occupancy

Fewer crowds and more privacy on your vacation.
